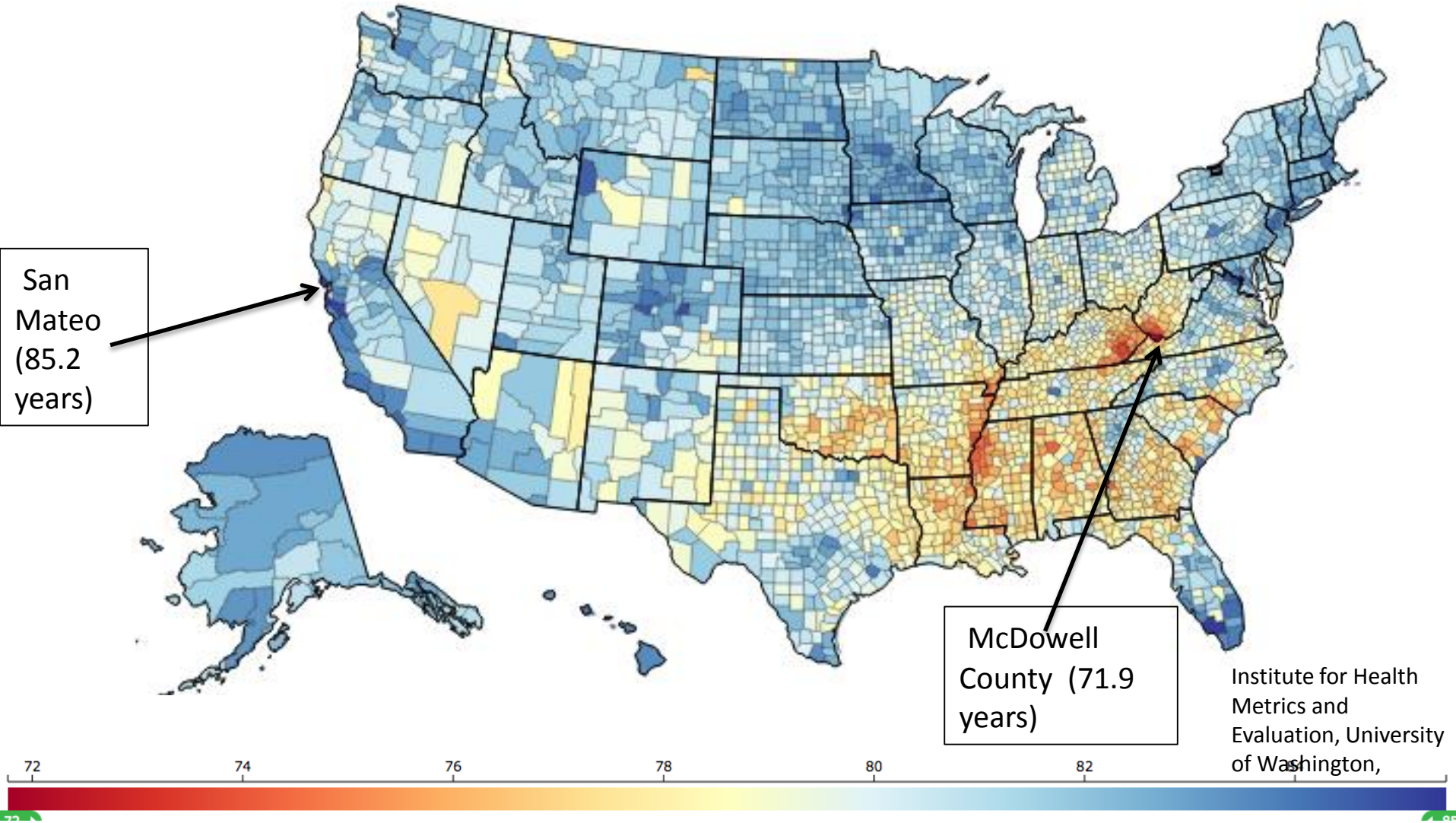




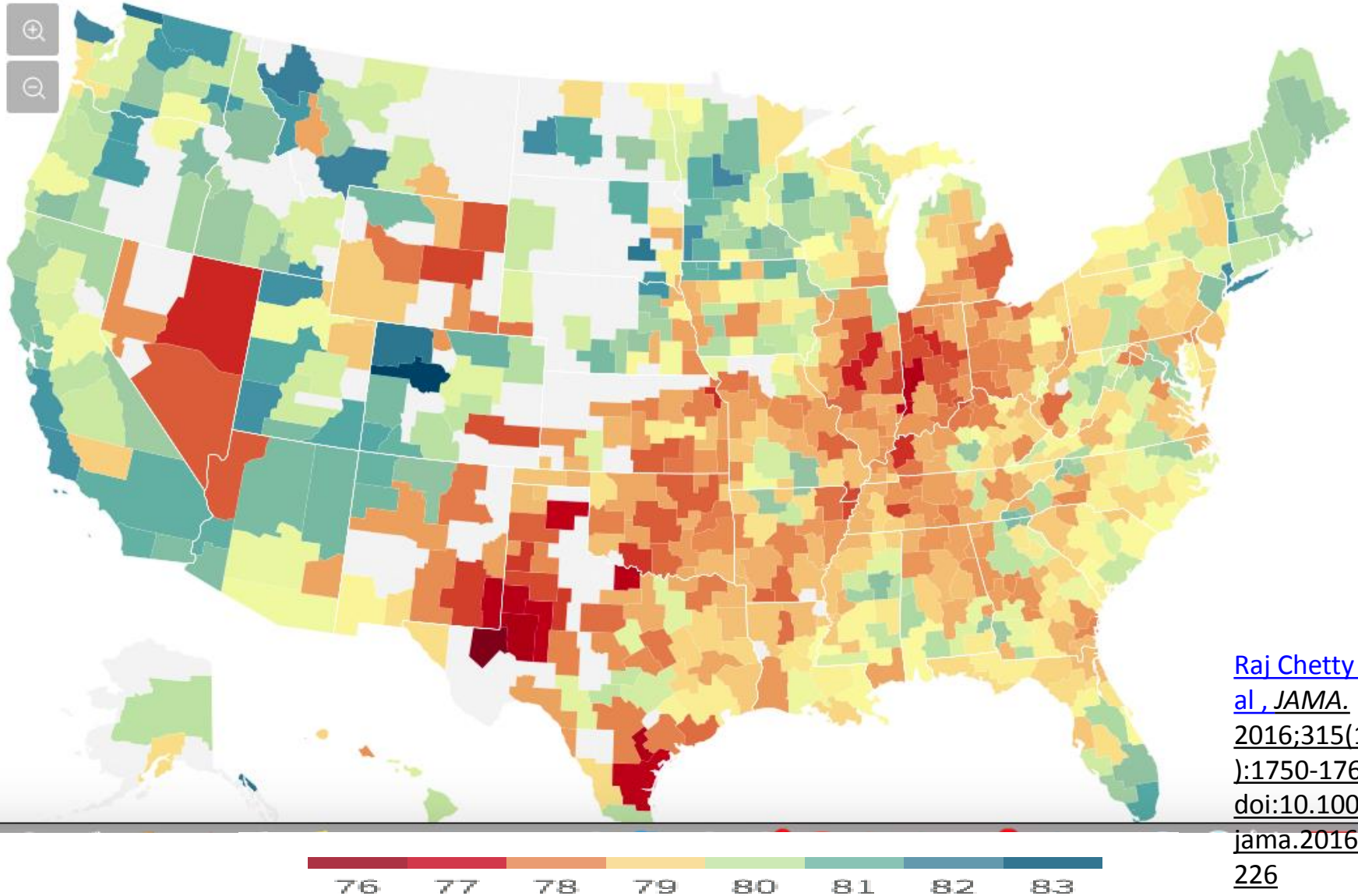

adjusted for race\*



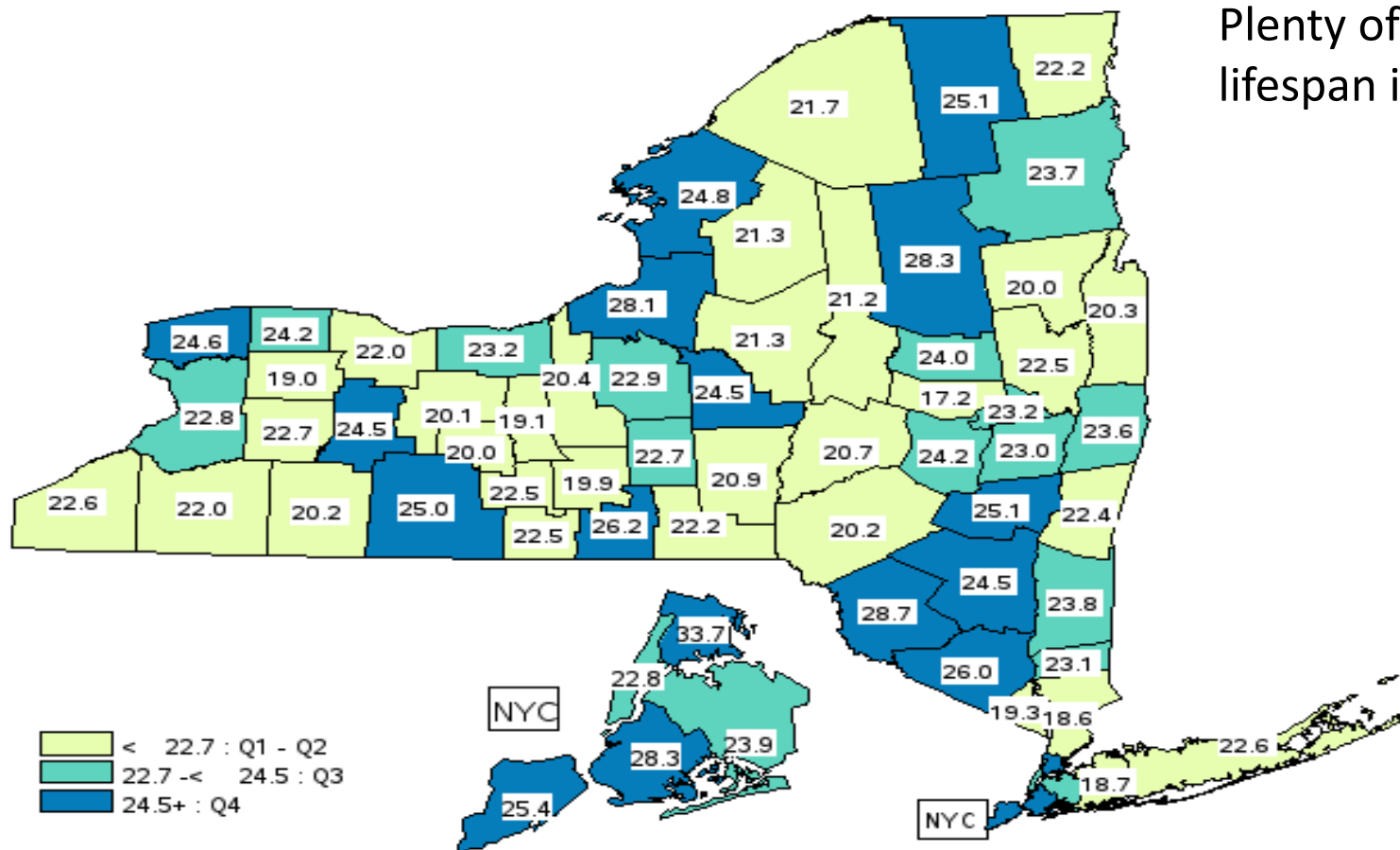

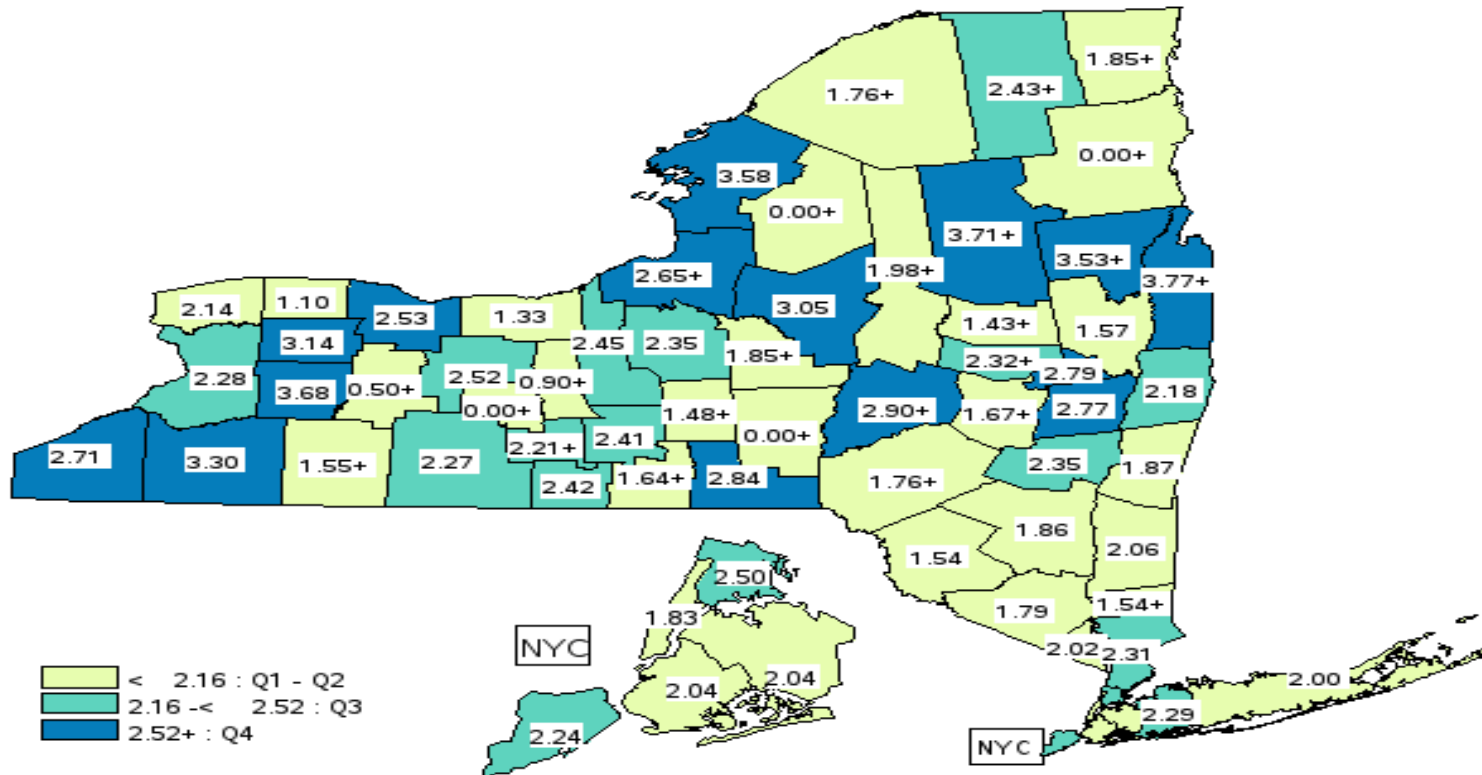
